REGISTRATION INFORMATION EVERY COACH SHOULD KNOW

TEAMS: •

- 1. Teams can roster up to a total of 19.
- 2. If 19 are rostered in Bantam and Midget, two (2) of the 19 MUST be goaltenders this applies to both recreational and carded/rep teams.

If less than 19 are rostered in Bantam and Midget, one (1) must be a goaltender – applies to both recreational and carded/rep teams.

- 3. The seasonal allotment of player certificates to ALL teams are:
 - a) Bantam and below 20
 - b) Midget 25
- 4. Any player released after January 10th is ineligible to be rostered to ANY team.
- 5. Teams can Affiliate up to a total of 19. In Bantam and Midget, should 19 AP's be rostered to a team, two (2) of the 19 must be goaltenders.
- 6. ALL teams must have a Head Coach, Safety Person and a Manager.

AFFILIATES:

- 1. At least one (1) Affiliate player MUST be added to a team by December 15th.
- 2. Final date to add to the Affiliate player list is January 15th.
- 3. The team wishing to affiliate a player, must obtain the approval from the player's rostered team.
- 4. The purposes of Affiliation are:
 - a) Player development
 - b) To replace injured, sick, suspended or non-attendance of players
- 5. Refer to BC Hockey Bulletin 2013-22-I and Hockey Canada Regulation E.35 a) and b) in regards to the number of games an Affiliate player can participate. Only league and playoff games count towards the 10 games allowed.
- 6. In regards to AP Goaltenders, only actual participation (in net) is considered as taking part in the game and such participation MUST be noted on the gamesheet.

TEAM OFFICIALS:

RECREATIONAL TEAMS:

- 1. Head Coach & Assistant Coach(s) must be qualified at the Coach 2 level and have an up to date Respect in Sport qualification.
- 2. Safety Person must be qualified with an up to date HCSP and RIS
- 3. Manager must be qualified with an up to date RIS

CARDED/REP TEAMS:

- Head Coach & Assistant Coach(s) must be qualified at the Development 1 level and have an up to date Respect in Sport qualification
- 2. Safety Person must be qualified with an up to date HCSP and RIS
- 3. Manager must be qualified with an up to date RIS

GAMESHEETS:

- 1. Only those players and Team Officials who are rostered to a team on the HCR may be shown on a gamesheet.
- 2. Affiliates are to be indicated by an "AP".
- 3. Overage Players are to be indicated by an "OA".
- 4. Only up to five (5) Teams Officials may be shown on a gamesheet. Only those who are "On the Bench" should be shown.
- 5. Should a player or Team Official be shown on a gamesheet who are NOT rostered to the team, BC Hockey Regulation 6.01 will be enforced.
 - "Any ineligible player or Team Official who signs the gamesheet and/or participates in any BC Hockey sanctioned game will cause their team to forfeit the game regardless of the score of the game. The team officials(s) responsible will be suspended indefinitely pending an investigation."
 - THE ABOVE APPLIES TO BOTH RECREATIONAL TEAMS AND CARDED/REP TEAMS!
- 6. Gamesheets SHOULD NOT be signed by the Manager.
